Feedback regarding curriculum, based on 14 parameters were collected from 110 students covering all the departments and disciplines. The inferences are drawn in terms of percentage based on the responses received from the students and details of the same are mentioned in the following table.

From the above table it is observed that the agreed percentage of students' responses towards the questions 3, 8, 9, 12 & 13 is more than 90%. Again, 88.18% of students agreed that the curriculum is easy to understand. Agreed percentage of students' responses towards the questions 1, 2, 7 & 14 is more than 85%. While in the questions 4, 5, 6 & 10 the agreed percentages of students' responses is more than 80%. Highest agreed percentage (95.45%) is observed against the completion of the curriculum in prescribed duration. And the lowest agreed percentage (79.09%) is observed against the use of ICT during the process of teaching.
