PT. JINTU GOGOI, VIR CHAKRA LIBRARY The Captain Jintu Gogoi, Vir Chakra Library is the central library of Joya Gogoi College established in the year 1992. The library has been named as 'Capt. Jintu Gogoi, Vir Chakra Library' as a mark of respect to the Kargil Martyr Capt. Jinta Gogoi in the year 2004. The library has a collection of 14,000 books including both university prescribed textbooks and a good number of reference books on each subject. 

# **FACILITIES FOR STUDENTS:**

#### A) CAPT. JINTU GOGOI, VIR CHAKRA LIBRARY:

The Captain Jintu Gogoi, Vir Chakra Library is the central Library of Joya Gogoi College, Khumtai established in the year 1992. The Library has been named as 'Capt. Jintu Gogoi, Vir Chakra Library' as a mark of respect to the Kargil Martyr Capt. Jintu

Gogoi in the year 2004. The Library has a collection of 16,250 books including both university prescribed textbooks and a good number of reference books on each subject. Besides the subject-oriented reference books on each as World Classic Books, General and Subject Encyclopedia, Yearbooks, Atlas, Dictionaries, Books on woman related issues, books on different issues of Northeast India, collection of award winning books of Sahitya Akademi, books on performing Art, Career guidance, Computer Science etc.



The library has 20 journals/ periodical and 6 newspapers. Out of 20 periodicals, 7 are peer-reviewed journals, one discussing journal on International Relation and foreign policy. The Library is also registered under the N-LIST consortium which provides access to 6000+ electronic journals and lots of e-books of world-class publishers. Besides the day to day activities, the library also provides the following services:

The Library provide "Late Priya Baruah & Late Girish Bora Memorial Best Reader Award" from the session 2003-04 And also provide "Late Romon Gogoi memorial best Eresource user award" from the session 2021-22 to one student for each academic session to inculcate the reading habit among the students.

# **ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING:**

The University shall issue an order to punish a student found guilty of ragging after following the procedure, and in the manner prescribed here in under.

- A) The Anti-Ragging Committee of the Institution shall take appropriate decision, in regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the recommendations of the anti-ragging squad.
- B) The anti-ragging committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the anti-ragging squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments:
  - I. Suspension from Attending Classes and Academic Privileges.
  - II. Withholding/ Withdrawing Scholarship/ Fellowship and other Benefits.
  - III. Debarring from Appearing in any Test/ Examination or other Evaluation Process.

- IV. Withholding results.
- V. Debarring from representing the institution in any Regional, National or International Meet, Tournament, Youth Festival, etc.
- VI. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- VII. Cancellation of admission.
- VIII. Rustication from the institution for a period ranging from one to four semesters.
- IX. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
- X. Fine of 10,000 /- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) or with imprisonment up to 6 months as per the Assam Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999.
- XI. To undertake patrolling and make surprise visits to places vulnerable to incidents of ragging.

# **COURSE STRUCTURE**

- a) Core Courses: Compulsory components of an Academic Programme. These Courses are to be compulsorily studied as a core requirement for the programme. The contents of the Core Courses shall be as per the UGC Model Curriculum for the subject/ discipline concerned.
- **b)** Elective Courses: Elective courses shall be chosen by each student from a pool of courses. These courses may be intra-departmental, i.e. Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) as well as inter-departmental, i.e., Generic Elective (GE). The students shall have to choose minimum number of DSE and GE in every semester as prescribed in the Course Structure.
- c) Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC): The Ability Enhancement Courses shall be of two kinds- 'Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses' and 'Skill Enhancement Courses'. These courses shall be inter-disciplinary (within the Programme) in nature. 'AEC' Courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to Knowledge enhancement. i. Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC):(a) Environmental

Science (2 Credit), (b) Communicative English (2 Credit) and (c) Alternative English/Communicative Hindi /MIL (2 Credit). Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC): (minimum 4 credits): These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill-based knowledge and should contain both theory and lab/hands on/training/fieldwork.

- **d)** A Course may also take the form of a Dissertation/ Project work/ Practical training/ Field work/ Seminar.
- **e)** A student shall have to study the academic programme as per the scheme of the Programme. Even if a candidate earns the required number of credits before completion of the full duration of the programme, he/she shall not be entitled for the degree.

#### **Attendance:**

A student who has less than 80% attendance in average shall not be permitted to sit for the End-semester examination. Provided that it shall be open to the University to grant exemption to a student who has attended a minimum of 70% classes but failed to obtain the prescribed 80% attendance for valid reasons, on recommendation of the Head/Chairperson/ Principals of the Department/ Centre/ College on payment of a prescribed fee(s).

#### **Examination and Evaluation:**

(a) Examination and evaluation shall be done on a continuous basis, at least three times during each semester. (b) There shall be 20% marks for internal assessment and 80% marks for End-semester examination in each course during every semester.

## **Results and Progression:**

A candidate shall be declared as passed a course, provided he/ she secures- (i) at least 40% of marks in each Course in the End Semester Examinations. (ii) at least 'P' grade in the 10 point scale combining both the in-semester and End Semester Examination performance. (iii) There shall be no separate pass mark for Internal Assessment.

#### **Grading System:**

The absolute grading system shall be applied in evaluating performance of the students. The following scale of grading system shall be applied to indicate the performances of students in terms of letter grade and grade points as given below:

# About Dibrugarh University Regulations for the Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) In Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) from the Academic Session, 2023-2024

Based on the new curricular framework as envisaged under the New Education Policy, 2020 by University Grants Commission (UGC) on the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS); Dibrugarh University designed the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) to provide multidisciplinary and holistic education, student centric, flexible choice based credit system with multiple entries/exits options to obtain a Certificate or a Diploma or Degree with or without Major or a Degree (Honours) or a Degree (Honours) with Research at various levels as stipulated under the policy. This is called Dibrugarh University Regulation for the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) and it is applicable for all the affiliated/permitted College of Dibrugarh University.

Undergraduate Programme will include the following:

- UG Certificate Programme: Students shall be awarded UG certificate in the Field of Study/Discipline after completing 1 year (both 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester) with requisite 44 credits on completion of 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester. In addition to this they have to complete one work based/skill based vocational course/internship of 4 credits within one year from the completion of 2<sup>nd</sup> semester examination.
- 2. **UG Diploma Programme**: Students shall be awarded UG Diploma in the Field of Study/Discipline after securing the requisite 88 credits on completion of 2 years (4 semesters). In addition to this they have to complete one work based/ skill based vocational course/internship of 4 credits one year from the completion of 4<sup>th</sup> semester examination.
- 3. Three Year UG Degree Programme (BA, B. Sc, B. Com and Bachelors in other disciplines) with single/double major: Students who wish to undergo a 3-year (6 semester) UG programme shall be awarded UG degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of three years, securing a minimum of 132 credits. Provision of double Major shall be implemented in due course of time.
- 4. Four Year UG Programme with honours (BA, B. Sc, B. Com and Bachelors in other disciplines) with single/double major: Students who wish to undergo a 4-year (8 semester) UG Programme shall be awarded UG Honours degree in the Major discipline after

successful completion of four years, securing a minimum of 176 credits. Provision of double Major shall be implemented in due course of time.

5. Four Year UG Programme with honours with Research (BA, B. Sc, B. Com and Bachelors in other disciplines) with single/double major: Students who wish to undergo a 4-year (8 semester) UG Programme shall be awarded UG Honours and research degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of four years with a rigorous research project, securing a minimum of 176 credits. Provision of double Major shall be implemented in due course of time.

FYUGP of Dibrugarh University has the following provisions:

1. **Multiple Exits and Entries**: FYUGP allows the students to have multiple exits and entries i.e. a student can exit the programme, say after one year and then again can enter the programme at a later time and can continue the programme from where he/she left if they fulfil the minimum eligibility criteria as given in Dibrugarh University Regulation.

2. **Academic Bank of Credits (ABC)**: As per the Dibrugarh University Regulation for FYUGP, all the credits of a student earn at the end of an examination will be deposited in the ABC account where the students have to register through ABC portal as notified by the University.

The entire Dibrugarh University FYUGP curriculum has the following categories of courses:

- 1. Major Discipline
  - Major Course (Core)
- 2. Minor Discipline
- 3. Multidisciplinary Generic Elective
- 4. Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC)
- 5. Value Added Courses (VAC)
- 6. Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)
- 7. Community Engagement
- 8. Field based learning/Project
- 9. Internship
- 10. Research Project/Dissertation

As per the availability of the courses in our college student can choose their courses based on their interest.

# **Course Enrolment**:

**Change in Major**: Students shall be allowed to change major within the broad discipline at the end of the second semester by giving him/her sufficient time to explore interdisciplinary courses during the first year.

**Change in Minor**: Students shall be allowed to change Minor courses of his/her areas of interest within the broad discipline at the end of the third semester

**Attendance**: A student should have at least 80% of attendance during the total number of class days. A student who has less than 80% attendance in average shall not be permitted to sit for the End Semester Examination.

**Betterment Examination**: A student shall be entitled to take the Betterment Examination in any two theory courses after successful completion of 3 year/ 4 year programme

#### **FACILITIES FOR STUDENTS:**

#### A) CAPT. JINTU GOGOI, VIR CHAKRA LIBRARY:

The Captain Jintu Gogoi, Vir Chakra Library is the central Library of Joya Gogoi College, Khumtai established in the year 1992. The Library has been named as 'Capt. Jintu Gogoi, Vir Chakra Library' as a mark of respect to the Kargil Martyr Capt. Jintu Gogoi in the year 2004. The Library has a collection of 16,250 books including both university prescribed textbooks and a good number of reference books on each subject. Besides the subject-oriented reference books on each as World Classic Books, General and Subject Encyclopedia, Yearbooks, Atlas, Dictionaries, Books on woman related issues, books on different issues of North-east India, collection of award winning books of Sahitya Akademi, books on performing Art, Career guidance, Computer Science etc.

The library has 20 journals/ periodical and 6 newspapers. Out of 20 periodicals, 7 are peer-reviewed journals, one discussing journal on International Relation and foreign policy. The Library is also registered under the N-LIST consortium which provides access to 6000+ electronic journals and lots of e-books of world-class publishers. Besides the day to day activities, the library also provides the following services:

5. Newspaper Clipping Services

The Library provide "Late Priya Baruah & Late Girish Bora Memorial Best Reader Award" from the session 2003-04 And also provide "Late Romon Gogoi memorial best E-resource user award" from the session 2021-22 to one student for each academic session to inculcate the reading habit among the students.

The college has constituted a Grievance Cell headed by Principal to look into and redress the grievance of the college employees (Teaching and Non-Teaching) and students.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING:**

The University shall issue an order to punish a student found guilty of ragging after following the procedure, and in the manner prescribed here in under.

- A) The Anti-Ragging Committee of the Institution shall take appropriate decision, in regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the recommendations of the anti-ragging squad.
- B) The anti-ragging committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the anti-ragging squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments:
  - I. Suspension from Attending Classes and Academic Privileges.
  - II. Withholding/ Withdrawing Scholarship/ Fellowship and other Benefits.
  - III. Debarring from Appearing in any Test/ Examination or other Evaluation Process.
  - IV. Withholding results.
  - V. Debarring from representing the institution in any Regional, National or International Meet, Tournament, Youth Festival, etc.
  - VI. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- VII. Cancellation of admission.
- VIII. Rustication from the institution for a period ranging from one to four semesters.
- IX. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
- X. Fine of 10,000 /- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) or with imprisonment up to 6 months as per the Assam Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999.
- XI. To undertake patrolling and make surprise visits to places vulnerable to incidents of ragging.
