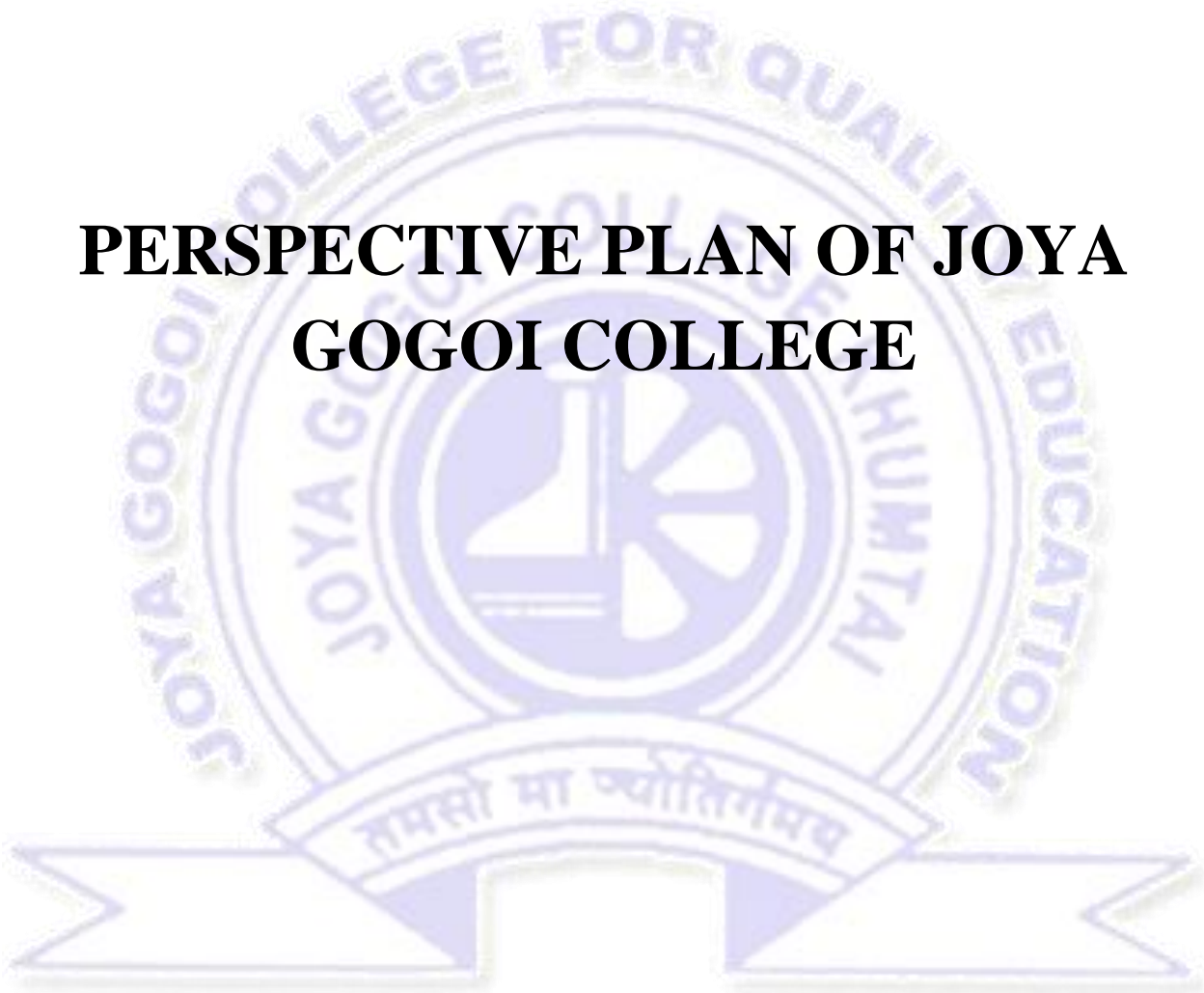
Mission of the College:

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Introduction

Joya Gogoi College was established on the 25th of November 1991 and is situated by sides of historic Dhodar Ali and at the geographic icon of greater Khumtai area, Golaghat District, Assam. Since its very inception in 1991, the college has been imparting quality higher education to the students of Khumtai locality and its adjoining areas. The college is affiliated to the Dibrugarh University and is registered under 2(F) and 12(B) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956.

From its inception, the Arts stream of the college has fostered quality education in the field of humanities and social sciences. To promote scientific temper among the students, the college administration sanctioned the Science stream from the department of higher education (DHE), Govt. of Assam in the year 2020. The college offers UG programmes in Arts and Science the specific departments of Arts and Science in the college. The college also offers distance learning education for UG and PG programmes under Krishna Kanta Handique Open State University (KKHSOU). Value added, Vocational certificate courses are offered to students which help the students in getting employability.

The governance and leadership are committed to executing the stated vision and mission of the college. Various academic and non-academic activities are commenced by the college to light the objectives of the vision statement. At the beginning of every academic session, the vision and mission of the institution are discussed with the students, teachers, staff and other stakeholders by holding general meeting. The Governing Body which is the supreme authority, has an active role in the overall management of the college. IQAC of the college. Besides, the IQAC of the college collects feedback from the students which are analyzed and communicated to the head of the institution for necessary action. It is an attempt to realize our future realistic goals of being premier higher educational institute in the state and imprint a unique identity for human values and intellectual resources. The college management constantly focuses on academic development, infrastructure improvement, good administrative management and innovation practices. Guided by the vision, we endeavour to shape the future of the youth towards high quality education, outstanding research, innovation and scholarship.

Academic Aspirations:

- ❖ Use of ICT enabled teaching and learning techniques by teachers and students are to be promoted.
- ❖ To increase the number of certificate, diploma, add-on and value-added courses for improvement of employability of the learners.
- ❖ To increase the participation of students in online courses through SWAYAM and online platform.
- ❖ The NEP task force of the college had prepared the Institutional Development Plan (IDP) for 15 years for implementation of NEP as instructed by Assam Govt. and submitted to the Govt. of Assam.
- ❖ The college authority will provide financial and other support to teachers and students for undertaking research activities, field visits etc.
- ❖ With the present faculties, the college will continue open distance learning institution under Krishna Kanta Handique Open State University for B.A. in UG and PG course.



Infrastructural Improvement:

The college administration has been working continuously for its infrastructural development to execute a conducive atmosphere for teaching and learning. Thus, improving infrastructure is the main focus while fostering the implementation of infrastructure schemes. The following schemes has focused on enhancing basic facilities like clean water, drainage, pollution control, building construction, furniture, books and technology services. These programmes have been formulated to ensure comprehensive support to the development and modernizing of new and existing infrastructural facilities. The primary schemes that have been proposed for the infrastructural improvement of the college are listed below.

- ❖ New buildings will be constructed to increase the number of classrooms.
- ❖ Most of the classrooms will be digitalized into smart classrooms with necessary facilities.
- ❖ To minimize human intervention, the IQAC and the college office will be digitalized and made fully automated by 2030.
- ❖ The college will build its own ERP portal for fully implementing e-governance in admission, online attendance, class routine, other information and financial transactions.
- ❖ Digital examination will be conducted by creating online examination module to increase the self confidence level of the students, digital friendly for various online competitive examinations.
- ❖ To increase the facilities of indoor stadium and build a gymnasium with necessary facilities.
- ❖ To implement schemes relating to green energy in addition to other enviro-promoting policies.
- ❖ The college campus will be made WIFI free for the students with enhanced internet speed.
- ❖ A new botanical garden with indigenous and medicinal plants will be established inside the college campus.
- ❖ Measures will be taken to foster sanitation to ensure good health and hygiene.
- ❖ Tree plantation will be done on a high priority to expand the green canopy of the campus.
- ❖ A vermicompost-shop managed by the department of Botany and English in association IQAC can be functional on campus.
- ❖ The college will enhance facilities for rainwater harvesting, waste recycling and waste management.

Administrative Management:

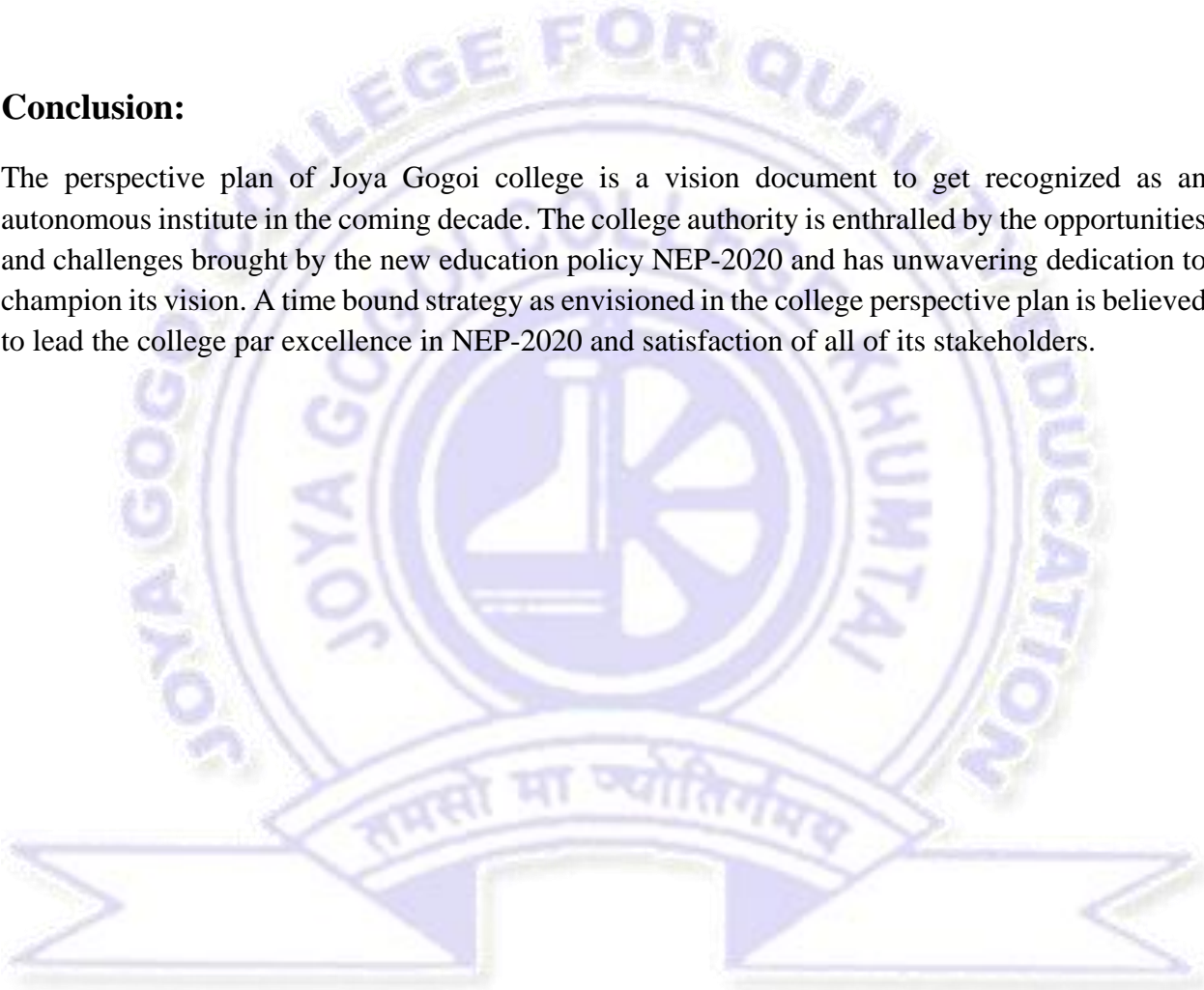
